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Subject Overview

This subject provides students with the opportunity to take responsibility and be accountable for their own learning whilst in the workplace.

During the semester, students expand their self-management and employability skills; including adaption to work place culture, time management and team work. Structured reflection on workplace practices and operations allows the student to contextualise knowledge and skills and provides an industry perspective for academic learning. Students will develop their self-awareness in relation to vocational planning and develop and enhance their professional identity.

Students are supported throughout the semester through a regular schedule of contact with the workplace coordinator and their subject tutor.
