Subject Overview

In this subject key management technology systems, processes and software are introduced and evaluated in relation a variety of business models. Students will assess business needs and identify appropriate IT system solutions in line with performance requirements, risk profile, budget constraints (including ongoing costs) and level of customisation. Concepts such as cyber security, privacy and protection of intellectual property are discussed and incorporated in decision making processes.
